TEXAS MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS

Texas Transportation Code 543.201, requires each magistrate or judge of a court not of record and each clerk of a court of record to keep a record of each case in which a person is charged with a violation of law regulating the operation of vehicles on highways.

Texas Transportation Code 543.203: Not later than the 30th day after the date of conviction or forfeiture of bail of a person on a charge of violating a law regulating the operation of a vehicle on a highway or conviction of a person of negligent homicide or a felony in the commission of which a vehicle was used, the magistrate, judge or clerk of the court in which the conviction was had or bail was forfeited shall immediately submit to the department a written record of the case containing the information required by Section 543.202.
